

Portfolio Requirements for Incoming Freshman

There is not a requirement for incoming freshmen in the Fall 2024 class to submit a portfolio. However, if you are interested in submitting an OPTIONAL portfolio, the guidelines are as follows:

Your design portfolio is demonstration of creative productivity that reveals your potential for artistry, craft, problem solving, illustration, and/or connecting with other people. It is a self-portrait and a declaration of your design skills, how you organize yourself and what is important to you.

You may submit architectural and/or visual creative work, such as images of your drawings, paintings, sculptures, graphic designs, etc. The portfolio can show that you have the motivation and skills to carry out architectural and/or creative work designs that you begin by including a variety of work or projects that you have carried to some level of completion. In regard to architectural work, the portfolio can demonstrate your ability to develop your design ideas from conceptual sketches, through drawings and study models, to the final design scheme. The portfolio can be a very diverse collection of various modes of representations, ranging from pencil drawings and physical models to digital drawings and renderings and animation stills.
